### **Dr. John P. Schaefer**

Dr. John P. Schaefer is President of Research Corporation, one of the first U.S. foundations and the only one wholly dedicated to the advancement of science. Born in New York City, Dr. Schaefer graduated from Polytechnic Institute of Brooklyn, earned a Ph.D. from the University of Illinois, and was awarded a National Science Foundation Research Fellowship at the California Institute of Technology. After a year as Assistant Professor at the University of California at Berkeley, he joined the University of Arizona faculty in 1960. In 1968 he became Head of the Department of Chemistry; in 1970 Dean of the College of Liberal Arts and served as President of the University of Arizona from 1971-82. In addition to the Research Corporation presidency, which he assumed in 1982, he is active on a number of industry boards, government and professional panels, and pursues interests ranging from ecology to photography. He is greatly concerned with the "pipeline issues" in science - the attraction of students to the scientific disciplines, the training of teachers, scientists and engineers, and the creation of the new scientific knowledge on which our material economic well-being depends.
